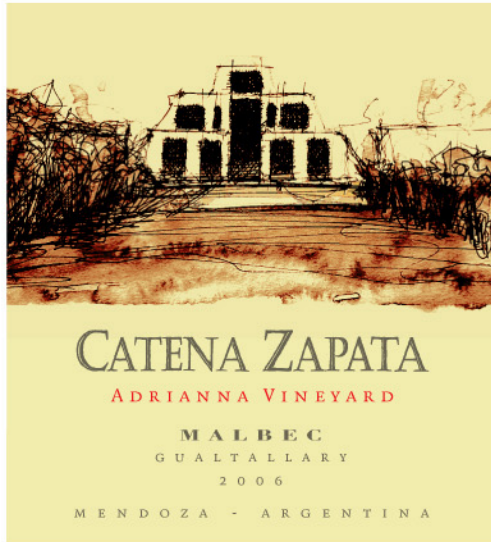


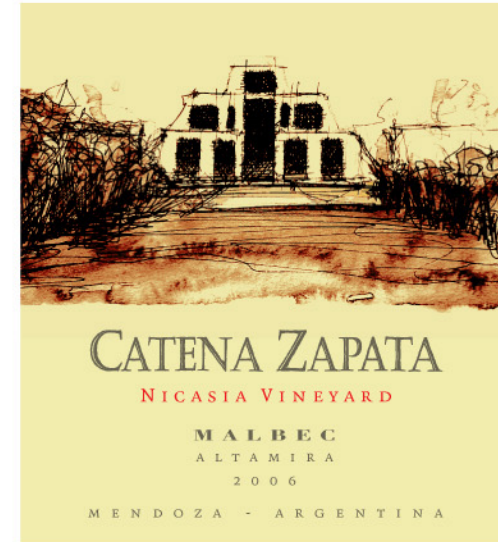

Adrianna Vineyard 2006
94 POINTS

This is powerfully rendered, with dark fig, black tea, melted licorice and plum sauce notes cascading over one another, while dense, loamy tannins provide support. Superdense on the finish, but with a long, supple texture that lets the fruit sail on.



Nicasia Vineyard 2006
95 POINTS
HOT WINES

Dense and layered, with loads of braised fig, currant paste, crushed plum and macerated blackberry fruit laced with licorice snap, black tea and spice notes. The long, broad finish has superb acidity buries deep, letting a floral hint skitter in the background. Shows impressive depth and range.
